John 14:18-26 (ESV)

18 "I will not leave you as orphans; I will come to you.
19 Yet a little while and the world will see Me no more, but you will see Me. Because I live, you also will live.
20 In that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

Prayer points:

- Thank God that we are not orphans, but His adopted children forever!
- Thank the Father that, though Jesus is no longer on this earth, He is living in us through the Holy Spirit.
- Thank the Father for our unity with Him and with Jesus.
- Pray that we will truly abide in Christ and live in His strength.
- Pray that those around us would truly experience Jesus' love through our words and actions.

21 Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him." 22 Judas (not Iscariot) said to him, "Lord, how is it that You will manifest Yourself to us, and not to the world?"

23 Jesus answered him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word, and my Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.

24 Whoever does not love Me does not keep my words. And the word that you hear is not Mine but the Father's Who sent Me.

Prayer points:

- Pray that we would show our genuine love for Jesus through obedience to His commands.
- Thank God for His love for us and His revealing Himself to us.
- Pray that we would follow Jesus' example in His submission to God the Father.

25 "These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you.

26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

Prayer points:

• Thank God for the continuing presence of the Holy Spirit, our <u>Helper</u>. Thank the Holy Spirit for the ways He helps you – be specific (defeating temptation, spiritual gifts, fruit of the Spirit, bringing the Word of God to mind, praying for us when we don't know what to pray, etc.).

- Pray that we would have open ears to the Holy Spirit able to hear Him over the noise of the world and our own temptations – and submissive hearts to His work.
- Pray that we would understand the Bible as the Holy Spirit sheds light on it for us and that we would be changed as a result.
