Prayer in the Book of Acts

Acts 1:14 (ESV): “All these were continually united in prayer, along with the women, including Mary the mother of Jesus, and His brothers.”

Prayer points:

- Pray that we as a church would be diligent and faithful in prayer.
- Pray that as we pray together, we would be united. Ask God to extend this unity from us to other local churches and to Christians around the world.

Acts 1:24-25 [in context of replacing Judas]: “And they prayed and said, ‘You, Lord, Who know the hearts of all, show which one of these two [Joseph or Matthias] You have chosen to take the place in this ministry and apostleship from which Judas turned aside to go to his own place.’”

Prayer points:

- Pray that we would diligently seek the Lord and be led by Him “Who know[s] the hearts of all,” and not by our own agenda.
- Thank God for the gift of His Holy Spirit – God Himself indwelling those who have been redeemed by Christ – Who leads and speaks to us today! [see verse 26]

Acts 2:42-47: “And they devoted themselves to the apostles’ teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the Apostles. And all who believed were together and had all things in common. And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.”

Prayer point:

- Pray that we would be devoted to:
 - Faithful biblical teaching
 - Fellowship
 - Breaking bread together (including the Lord’s Supper)
 - Prayers
 - Sacrificially giving to care for one another
 - Praising God
 - Seeing God add new believers to our number
